

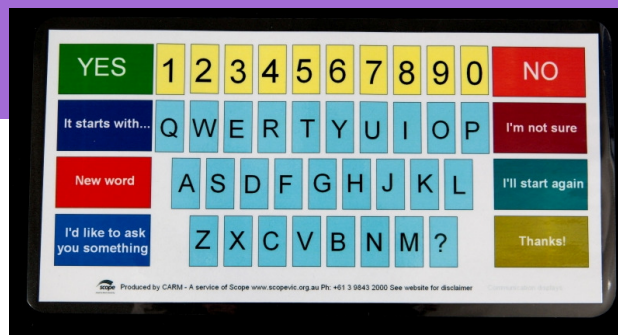
NECAS

The Non-electronic Communication Aid Scheme (NECAS) provides non-electronic communication aids to adults with complex communication needs in Victoria.

Communication aids can help people communicate.

Non-electronic communication aids include boards, books and cards that have a series of pictures, letters, words or phrases printed on them.

Who can apply?

Adults who

- Are 18 years or over
- Have complex communication needs
(no speech at all or speech that other people find difficult to understand)
- Live in Victoria
- Have a Medicare card
- Are eligible for services under the Disability Act (2006)



How to apply

Complete the NECAS Service Request Form.

It is recommended that a speech pathologist helps you complete the form. If this is not possible, anyone who knows you and how you communicate can complete the Service Request Form.
